2021-2022 Parent and Family Engagement Plan

- 7. Chackbay Elementary School, with the assistance of its parents, will educate its teachers, support personnel, and school leaders in the value of parents/families, and in how to reach out to, communicate, and work with parents, as equal partners, to build ties between the parents and the school by: PTC meetings, weekly test folders with behavior comments to be signed and returned, PD, PLC grade level meetings, email, Google classroom
- 8. Chackbay Elementary School will, to the extent feasible and appropriate, coordinate and integrate parental involvement programs and activities with other Federal, State, and local programs, including public preschool programs, and conduct other programs such as parent resource centers by: Hosting parent activities at school/virtual, parent resources can be checked out, providing tours for Head Start and future students and new families, hosting transition meetings and suggestions on webpage
